Broadcom Israel strives to provide every employee with an opportunity to volunteer in an activity that suits him or her. Although their initiatives cover a variety of great volunteer programs, this salute is for their leadership as mentors to students at one of Tel-Aviv's tougher neighborhood schools.

The Israel team organized a movie event to socialize with parents and children and also donated a TV, DVD player and movies to the class.

Employees participated in a workshop to learn about the challenges facing these kindergartners and how to effectively interact with this age group. For four months thereafter, one or two Broadcom volunteers visited the kindergarten each Sunday for a two hour "workshop" where they read books to the children and engaged in an activity related to the story.

During June "Book Week", employees helped parents make special library bags for their children to bring a book home once a week and presented 200 books donated by the Israel team.



In another project, Yahud employees volunteered to tutor children from needy families in local school. Children came to the Yahud office once a week for a one-on-one meeting with a volunteer, spending quality time learning math and playing strategic games. This project provided a great opportunity to contribute to the local community and to give these children exposure to Broadcom's environment of excellence.
