Exam Details (Last Updated: 08/15/2025)

The VMware Cloud Foundation 9.0 Support (2V0-15.25) exam, which leads to VMware Certified Professional – VMware Cloud Foundation Support Certification (VCP-VCF Support), is a 60-item exam in English with a passing score of 300 using a scaled method. Candidates are given an appointment time of 135 minutes, which includes adequate time to complete the exam for non-native English speakers.

Minimally Qualified Candidate

The candidate can apply standard troubleshooting techniques and methodologies to issues identified during the deployment, and running, of a VMware Cloud Foundation (VCF) 9.0 Fleet. The candidate must possess a high level understanding of a VMware Cloud Foundation 9.0 Fleet solution, including the features, functions, components and architecture models. The VMware Cloud Foundation 9.0 Fleet components include VCF Operations, VCF Automation, SDDC Manager, vCenter, VMware ESX, VMware NSX, VMware vSAN, HCX, VMware Operations for logs, VMware Operations for networks, and VCF Fleet Management.

The candidate will have a minimum of 1 year experience supporting and troubleshooting VMware Cloud Foundation components, either in isolation or as part of a VMware Cloud Foundation Fleet/Instance. In addition, the candidate will have at least 2 years of overall IT experience. When called upon, the candidate may occasionally need to research various advanced VCF-related support topics or troubleshooting tasks, and may even request assistance from a colleague or Broadcom support. The candidate possesses most of the knowledge shown in the exam sections (blueprint).
